**Background / Discussion**

As May marks both Melanoma and Skin Cancer Awareness Month and the beginning of summer, it is imperative that communities across Canada be reminded of the importance of sun safety at this time of the year. Over-exposure to UV radiation is the leading cause of melanoma and non-melanoma skin cancers. Skin cancer is the most common of all cancers.
