

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Past Recovery Archaeological Services Inc. was retained by P.H. Robinson Consulting to undertake a Stage 2 archaeological assessment of a property located at 1335 Reneal Street on Part Lot 9, Concession 2 of the geographic Township of Cornwall, now part of the City of Cornwall (see Maps 1 to 3). This assessment follows the recommendations of a previous Stage 1 archaeological assessment for the property, also undertaken by Past Recovery (2016), which found that portions of the property retained potential for archaeological resources.

The purpose of the Stage 2 assessment was to determine whether archaeological resources, artifacts or sites with cultural heritage value or interest were present on the property and to determine whether these resources required further assessment. The Stage 2 assessment of the 1335 Reneal Street property was undertaken on September 7th, 2016. The assessment was conducted by means of a shovel test pit survey at five metre intervals across those areas determined to have archaeological potential. No archaeological sites of cultural heritage value or interest were found during the Stage 2 assessment of the property

This report forms the basis for the following recommendations:

- 1) No further archaeological assessment of the subject area as presently defined in Maps 2 and 3 is required. As a result, clearance of the archaeological condition placed on the study area should be granted.

The reader is also referred to Section 5.0 below, to ensure compliance with the Ontario Heritage Act as it may relate to this project.
